






Junior Colleges/ Centralised Institute	Polytechnics	Institute of Technical Education (ITE)	Arts Institutions (LASALLE & NAFA)
Prepares students for <u>A-Levels</u> over <u>2</u> years (or 3 years) before pursuing University education	Provides <u>Diploma</u> courses that prepare students for the <u>workforce</u>	Provides education for students with an aptitude for <u>hands-on learning</u>	Hands-on (diploma/degree) courses with a focus on visual and performing arts (e.g. Fine Arts, Music, Dance, Media, etc.)



- Provides students with learning opportunities in 3 areas: life skills, knowledge, and subject disciplines
- Flexible choice and diversity in choice of subject combinations with subjects offered at 3 levels of study: H1, H2, or H3
- Need to offer a contrasting subject subject outside your main area of specialisation - to broaden one's educational experience

 Allows students to apply to a school before taking the O-Level examinations. Students are recognised based on their talents in sports, arts, CCAs and other areas that may not be demonstrated in the O-Levels.

 If the DSA is successful, the student will be given a spot in JC as long as he/she meets the requirements




Direct School Admission (DSA) for JC

DSA Admission Requirements

- 1. L1R5 score of 20 and below
- 2. At least a C6 for English
- 3. At least a D7 for A and E math
- 4. At least a D7 in express Mother Tongue, E8 for Higher Mother Tongue and pass/merit in Mother Tongue 'B'

If the student does not meet the subject requirements but meets the conditions below, will still be eligible for conditional admission:

- L1R5 ≤ 15
- L1R5 from 16 to 20 and have grades of 'A1' or 'A2' in all the 5 relevant subjects

Early Admission Exercise (EAE) for Polytechnics

 This is an aptitude-based admission exercise that allows students to apply for and receive conditional offers for admission into polytechnics prior to their O-Level result release.

- All five polytechnics participate in the EAE exercise namely:
 - Ngee Ann Polytechnic
 - Nanyang Polytechnic
 - Singapore Polytechnic
 - Republic Polytechnic
 - Temasek Polytechnic


Polytechnic EAE Admission Requirements

For O-Level holders:

- i. A net ELR2B2 score of 26 points or better for the GCE O-Level examinations*; and
- ii. Minimum Entry Requirements (MERs) for the polytechnic course you have been offered under Poly EAE*. The MERs for each polytechnic course can be found on the polytechnics' websites.

Note: ELR2B2 is used for admission into the polytechnics. It refers to:

- EL: English Language
- R2: 2 relevant subjects for the polytechnic course applied for
- B2: 2 other best subjects which could be elective subjects



Early Admission Exercise (EAE) for Polytechnics

O-Level students applying via Poly EAE will go through the following process:

Process	Period
Application Stage	24 Jun (Thu) to 30 Jun (Wed)
Selection Stage	5 Jul (Mon) to 31 Aug (Tue)
Offer & Acceptance Stage	7 Sep (Tue) 1400h to 10 Sep (Fri) 2359h
Withdrawal Stage	13 Sep (Mon) to 15 Oct (Fri) 2359h

*Based on 2021 EAE exercise.






