


# ECG ADVISING FACT SHEET FOR EDUCATORS

## JOINT ADMISSIONS EXERCISE (JAE) FOR O-LEVEL STUDENTS

Some questions for discussion with your students

- How are you feeling?
- In what areas would you like to develop, as you take your next step forward?
- What are your plans or goals for your next step forward?
- How do your education and career plans align with your **Values, Interests, Personality and Skills (VIPS)**?
- How do you plan to overcome some of the challenges that you are presently facing or may face in the future?
- Is there a trusted adult you can discuss your plans with?
- How will you find out more information relating to your education and career plans? What support do you need?



Remind students that they

- have many opportunities and pathways available for continuous learning as they plan for their education and career journey.
- have been equipped with the necessary skills to address their education and career concerns they may have. Work with them to revisit the skills and strategies they have demonstrated when facing challenges and explore ways to pursue their goals.
- have many significant people in their life whom they can rely on for support when making their education and career decisions and choices. Support them in identifying these people.
- are taking ownership of their education and career goals when they take positive steps forward. Encourage them to consider the next step(s) they can take.

## JOINT ADMISSIONS EXERCISE (JAE) FOR O-LEVEL STUDENTS

### Admission Requirements

### JC / MI

#### Eligibility:

- JC: **L1R5 ≤ 20** / MI: **L1R4 ≤ 20**
- Meet **Subject Requirements** for JC / MI admission

#### Posting by merit is based on:

- JC: **Net L1R5** / MI: **Net L1R4**

### Polytechnic

#### Eligibility:

- **Net ELR2B2-A/B/C/D ≤ 26** (except Diploma in Nursing ≤ 28)
- Meet **Minimum Entry Requirements (MER)** of the course selected

#### Posting by merit is based on:

- **Net ELR2B2-A/B/C/D**, depending on the course selected

### ITE 2-Year Higher Nitec

#### Eligibility:

- Meet **Minimum Entry Requirements (MER)** of the course selected

#### Posting by merit is based on:

- **Net ELB4-A, ELRIB3-B, ELR2B2-C**, depending on the course selected

- Students who are keen on courses in **LASALLE/NAFA** should **apply directly** to LASALLE/NAFA and **NOT** via **JAE**
- Students may also apply for **Nitec & 3-year Higher Nitec<sup>^</sup>** Courses and **Traineeship** Courses via **JIE 'O'**

<sup>^</sup>There will be 25 3-year Higher Nitec Courses available for the AY2024 intake

### JC / MI

Subject	Requirement
English Language	A1 to C6
Mother Tongue	A1 to D7
<b>OR</b> Higher Mother Tongue	A1 to E8
<b>OR</b> Mother Tongue 'B'	Merit or Pass
Maths / Add. Maths	A1 to D7

Students who **do not meet the subject requirements** may still be eligible for **conditional admission** to JC/MI, **subject to other requirements**.

Students should **consider their relevant grades** (e.g. ELR2B2-B in this example) in **Form A** and use the **Net ELR2B2 aggregate point range for previous year** as **a guide to gauge their chances** of admission to the course. **Charmaine (Singaporean)**

**Gross: 12 points**

**Net: 12pts**

10th choice: Diploma in ...

11th choice: Diploma in ...

**12th choice: Diploma in ABC**

**Hazim (Singaporean)**

**Gross: 14 points**

**Net: 12pts (CCA 2 points)**

**1st choice: Diploma in ABC**

2nd choice: Diploma in ...

3rd choice: Diploma in ...

- Posting is based on **merit**, according to **net aggregate point**
- If students with same net aggregate point vie for the last place, posting will be based on:
  - **citizenship status**, followed by,
  - **gross aggregate point**, followed by,
  - **computerised ballot**

E.g. Charmaine and Hazim are **vying for the last place** in the same course.

**Net aggregate point** - Both have 12 points

**Citizenship status** - Both are Singaporeans

**Gross aggregate point** - Hazim's **14** (2 CCA points) vs Charmaine's **12** (no CCA points)

*Charmaine has better gross aggregate points, and is offered the course, even though she put the course as her last choice while Hazim chose it as his first choice.*



When students are **NOT** posted to any of their registered choices...

*Priority given to eligible applicants (based on MER) who chose Diploma in Nursing in NYP or NP as FIRST choice*



For **JC/MI courses**

- **Approach JC/MI directly** after release of posting
- Must **meet 2 conditions\***
- Outcome to be provided by JC/MI, **subject to available vacancies and school's admission criteria**

**\* 2 conditions:**

- Meets the admission requirements to JC/MI
- Meets the aggregate point of **lowest ranked** student in the course

For **Polytechnic or ITE courses**, as well as **students who have NOT been posted to any course**

- **Appeal online at <https://jaeappeal.edu.sg>**
- Results will be released through the portal
- Must **meet 2 conditions\***

At end of the combined appeals period, **all unposted students** will be **offered a place** in a Polytechnic or ITE course with remaining vacancies, **subject to 2 conditions\***

**\* 2 conditions:**

- Meets the MER for their chosen Polytechnic or ITE courses
- Meets the aggregate point of **lowest ranked** student in the course
