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Last time

ITE currently offers the Nitec and Higher Nitec courses separately. Students who finish their Nitec level must apply to enrol in a Higher Nitec course.

Students take four years to graduate with Nitec and Higher Nitec certificates .

Enhanced Curricular Structure Built to Equip ITE Graduates for Their Careers

The Institute of Technical Education (ITE) is making steady strides towards the full implementation of its enhanced three-year curricular structure leading directly to a *Higher Nitec* certification, by the Academic Year (AY) 2026. This initiative, introduced in 2022, is designed to provide ITE graduates with deeper industry-relevant skills, enhancing their employability and establishing a robust foundation for continuous education and skills development throughout their careers.

In a phased approach that commenced in 2022, ITE successfully launched eight three-year *Higher Nitec* courses that year, followed by the introduction of three additional courses in 2023. The momentum continues with plans to unveil 14 more three-year *Higher Nitec* courses in 2024. The list of the 25 courses introduced over the years can be found in *Annex B*.



Investing in mid-career S'poreans, ITE grads



SkillsFuture Level-Up Programme for those aged 40 and above

- \$4,000 SkillsFuture Credit (Mid-Career) top-up in May for selected training courses with better employability outcomes
- Mid-Career Enhanced Subsidy for another publicly funded full-time diploma
- Up to \$3,000 monthly SkillsFuture Mid-Career Training Allowance for up to 24 months for selected full-time courses

ITE Progression Award for younger ITE grads pursuing diploma

- Top-up of \$5,000 to Post-Secondary Education Account upon enrolment
- Top-up of \$10,000 to CPF OA upon completion

Thus, the minimum GPA for ITE students to qualify for polytechnics will be raised from 2 to 2.5, from the AY2027 polytechnic intake. This is to ensure students can better cope with the academic rigour of a polytechnic education, MOE said.

Apart from a polytechnic diploma, Higher Nitec graduates also have the option of upgrading via the work-study diploma and technical diploma programmes, which offer more hands-on training.

By 2025, both pathways will offer 1,800 places, up from 1,400 currently.

ITE Admission



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E EAE (May - August)

- Aptitudes & interests in a specific field of study-based
- Assessment will be through different modes (e.g. interviews, portfolio, aptitude tests etc)
- Minimum entry requirement will still
 have to be met
- Main advantage: Do not need to compete for admission into ITE strictly based on the National Examinations results

EAE Information



The ITE Early Admissions Exercise (ITE EAE) allows you to apply for ITE courses based on your **aptitude and interests**, before taking your GCE N- or O-Level exams.

If you choose not to apply to ITE through ITE EAE, you may still do so through other admissions exercises, such as the Joint Intake Exercise (JIE) or Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE).

ITE EAE is open to:

- Students who are Singapore Citizens / Singapore Permanent Residents and registered to sit for GCE N- or O-Levels in 2023;
- International Students currently in Government, Government-aided or Independent Schools who are registered to sit for GCE N- or O-Levels in 2023; and
- Singapore Citizens / Singapore Permanent Residents who have taken the GCE N- or O-Level examinations previously.

Your conditional offer will be automatically confirmed if you meet subjectspecific Minimum Entry Requirements (MERs) for the course. If your ITE EAE offer is confirmed after the release of the 2023 GCE results, you <u>will not</u> be eligible to participate in the upcoming JIE or JAE.

Prepare for your application

Prepare the write-up (up to around 100 words) for each course you are applying for. Express your passion for the course in your write-up. Include your relevant skills/activities/experiences that demonstrate your aptitude for the course.

If shortlisted, prepare for interview

Bring along supporting documents e.g. portfolio of related works, evidence of relevant experiences, and CCA records to the interview.
