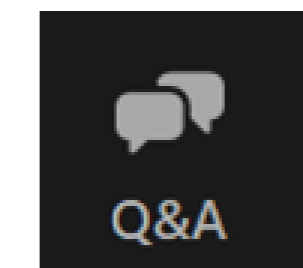

Key Considerations & Timeline



Key Considerations

Students are allocated to a subject combination based on the following:

- **Merit** which is according to students' academic results
- **Choices** submitted for the Subject Allocation Exercise (SAE)
- **Availability** of school resources (teacher manpower, facilities and class size)

Note: For students taking subject(s) at a more demanding level in Sec 2 (i.e. Subject-Based Banding, or SBB), the offering of Out-of-Stream (OOS) subject(s) in Sec 3 will be considered based on merit (See Slide 22).



Upper Secondary Subject Combinations and Eligibility Criteria

Key Considerations

From 2023 onwards

- The minimum number of subjects for 'O'/'N' Level registration is **5**
- Students who are offered **7** subjects will have longer curriculum hours.

Note: Subjects offered are centred on the **best interests** of the student, **progression pathways** and **availability of resources**.

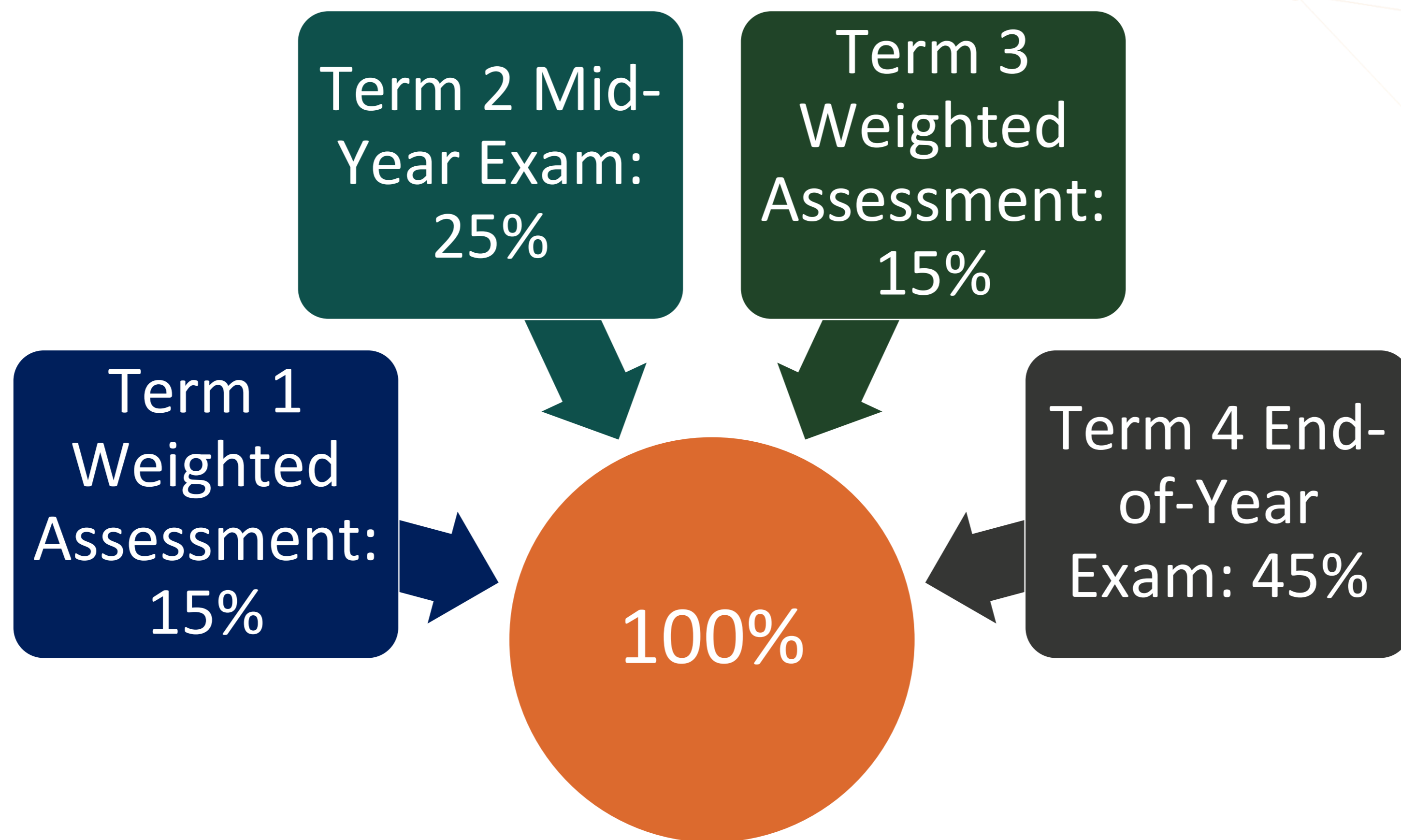

Pure History	Pass History
Pure Geography	Pass Geography

Subject	Criteria (<u>Sec 2 Overall Marks</u>)
Mobile Robotics (MR)	<u>Top 20 students</u> based on average of Math AND Science marks
Art	Art must be <u>Grade C and above</u>
Design & Technology (D&T)	Pass D&T



Sec 2 Promotion Criteria (eStudent Handbook Pg 27)

Course	Promotion Criteria
Express	<ul style="list-style-type: none">At least 50% pass in English Language AND at least 50% of the year's total marks across the 10 examinable subjects
Normal Academic	<ul style="list-style-type: none">At least 50% pass in English Language AND at least 50% pass in 2 other subjectsOR at least 50% pass in any 4 subjects
Normal Technical	<ul style="list-style-type: none">At least 50% pass in English Language or Mathematics AND a pass in one other subject



Criteria for Lateral Transfer

1. Meet Sec 2 promotion criteria
2. At least 70% of the year's total marks across all examinable subjects

Normal Technical (NT)

Normal Academic (NA)

Express (EXP)

2022 Sec 2 NT may transfer laterally to 2023 Sec 2 NA

2022 Sec 2 NA may transfer laterally to 2023 Sec 3 EXP



School's Criteria for Offering Out-of-Stream (OOS) Subject

Criteria for Lateral Transfer	Subject-Based Banding (SBB) subjects in Sec 2	Criteria for offering OOS subjects in Sec 3 (up to 3 subjects)
Student met criteria for lateral transfer		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No criteria is set• Depends on subject teacher's recommendation
Student did not meet criteria for lateral transfer	Student is taking SBB subject in Sec 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• At least 50% pass in that subject• Only Combined Science (no Pure Sciences)
	Student did not take SBB subject in Sec 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• At least 75% in that subject AND at least 60% of the year's total marks across all examinable subjects• Only Combined Science (no Pure Sciences)

Discuss with your child on possible pathways to consider.

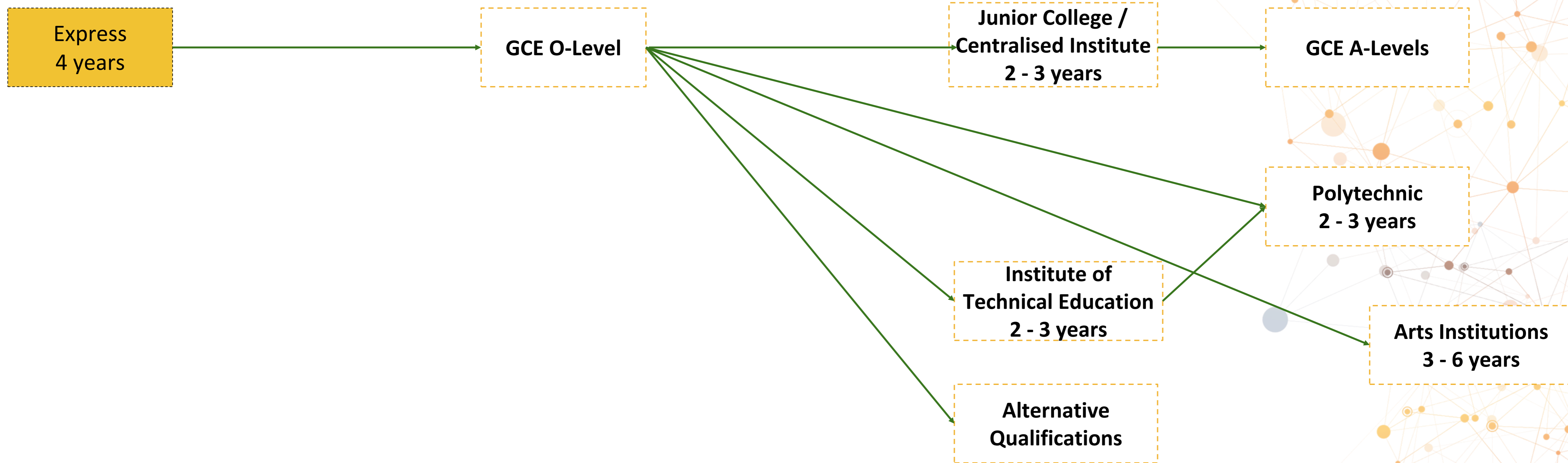

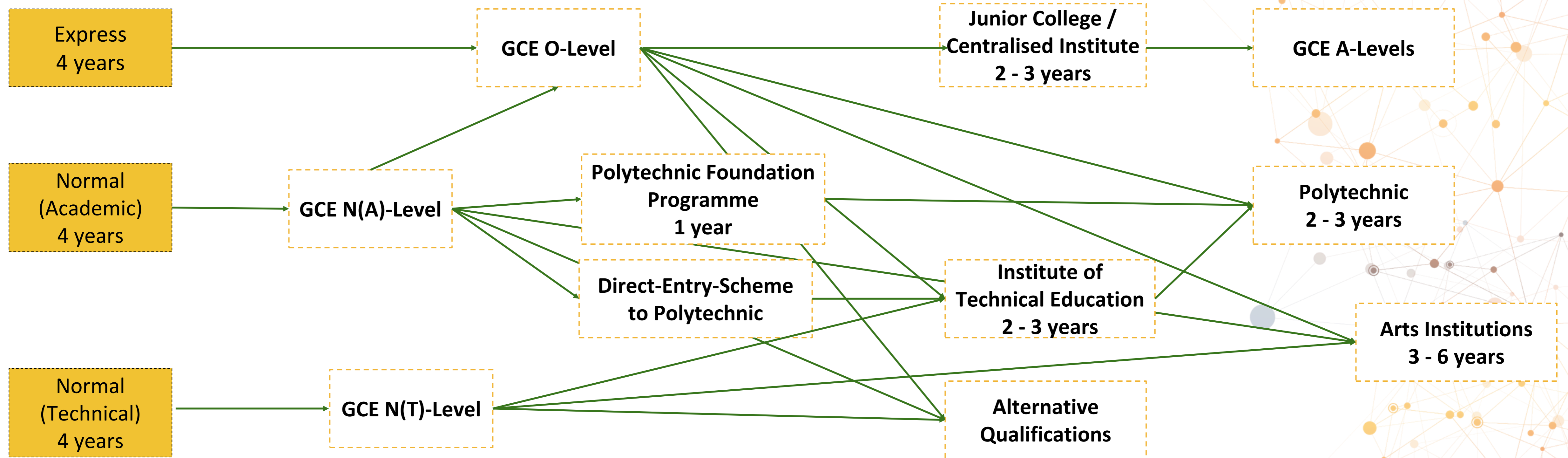
