## Updates on School Events and Programmes (2021 Term 4 – Sec 4N(A) & 4N(T))

1. With the arrival of Term 4, all Sec 4N students will be sitting for their GCE N(A)/N(T)-Level Year-End National Examinations.

### Graduation Ceremony

3. To keep our students safe, we will continue to suspend mass physical gatherings. The Graduation Ceremony on **30 September (Thursday)** will be classroom-based to minimise intermingling across classes. Other MOE Safe Management Measures, such as proper wearing of masks and fixed seating one metre apart, remain in place.
4. Students will be required to wear **full school uniform** (uniform with pants/skirt). Black shoes, black socks and proper hairstyles are mandatory.

### Study Break for Sec 4N students

6. In the lead-up to the Year-End National Examinations, the first study break has been implemented from 4 September (Saturday) to 12 September (Sunday). The second study break will commence from **1 October (Friday) to 3 October (Sunday)**.

7. During the study break, students are **strongly encouraged to remain at home** to reduce their risk of contracting COVID-19. This would also serve to minimise the risk of school-based transmissions and reduce the number of students placed on Quarantine Order and Leave of Absence. Students should make use of the study break to revise for their examinations and clarify the questions they have with their teachers online.
8. Students who require additional support (i.e. those whose home environment may not be conducive for studying) may return to school, with the following additional safe management measures in place:
  - (i) Temperature-taking during check-in
  - (ii) Attendance-taking with check-in and check-out timings clearly indicated
  - (iii) Self-study would be conducted with fixed examination style seating and at least 2m spacing. Strictly no group work is allowed
